2021 Rules: Judging begins at 1:00 pm. Agricultural Hall will be closed to the public during judging.

Exhibitors may enter an entry items in an entry department as they wish but OAGF uses farm-pet categories.

All premium numbers are the same for all divisions.

Each exhibit will receive only one award and possibly a special award. Only two (2) awards per premium number/entry will be awarded. All special awards are in addition to the standard fair premiums and are the decision of the judge. Items will be assigned by the department chairman.

Youth Division: Dept. L-R. Exhibitors ages 18 or of Fair Day. 17 and under are encouraged to participate in the "Youth Division". An exhibitor in the youth division will also receive participation ribbon for all other entries with no cash award.

Junior Division: in foods and sewing Dept. H & K. Exhibitors that are 12 years of age but have not reached their 18th birthday by entry day of the current fair year are eligible.

Adult & Junior Premium Awards will be \$1.00 for blue ribbon and \$1.00 for red ribbon.

*Youth Awards will be \$1.00 for blue ribbon and \$1.00 for red ribbon.
