Any American make car can run with the following exceptions: No 1979 or older Lincoln, No 1973 or older Chrysler Imperial or Imperial sub-frames, No's, ambulances, hearse, trucks, limousines, frames or full cars etc...

1. Overall condition must be safe. This applies to used cars as well as fresh cars. If the officials deem the car unsafe to run, it will not run. **The officials' decision is final.**

- ALL RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED, OR YOU WILL NOT RUN
- All drivers must sign the driver's paperwork, or they will not drive in the event
- All drivers and crew members must attend the drivers meeting
- No hot rodding in the pits, keep it all an off. This will be the quickest way to be **DISQUALIFIED**
- You are given 1 minute to make an aggressive hit. After 1 minute that particular car will be drop offed. You are only given 1 minute in total, not 1 minute to get started and 1 minute to hit
- No drivers are allowed alcohol period. If you are wearing a drivers band and drinking any form of alcohol YOU WILL BE **DISQUALIFIED**
- Cars will be re-inspected before any prize money is paid out. The cars will be re-inspected by the Tech staff only. Everything else will stay lock until cars are deemed to be legal
- Any complaints that a driver file about a piece of car prior to the start of the first heat will need to be addressed in the driver's meeting in specifics. If nothing is said, we don't want to hear about it after the drive
- Any questions, **ASK!** These rules callus... if it does not say you can do it **THEN DON'T.** We can't stress enough to call first
- Judges decisions are **FINAL!**

2. **SFI-1 or better, Certified fire jacket required.** SFI-1 or better, pants recommended. Long pants are required. Eye protection, neck brace and gloves highly recommended. Shoes are required.

3. Minimum of FDOT rated helmet required. Full-face helmets recommended.

4. Seat belts are required, must be functional, and fastened to the floor or seat bracket and must be worn at all times. **Officials' decision is final.**

5. Car must be fully stripped of all flammable material. Factory seats and factory dash are allowed. All glass, chrome, door handles, and any unsafe items must be removed from the inside and outside of the cars. All plastic, stainless and pot metal trim, fiberglass, and rubber must be removed from the outside of the car. Car floor, trunks, and inside of doors must be swept of glass, debris, and must be clean. Factory floor drain plugs must be removed.
