**GENERAL RULES**

- 1) Calf must be a 4-H project if it has a 4-H tag, must be unbranded
  - 2) Calf must be under 18 mos.
  - 3) Calf must be weaned but not clipped
  - 4) Showman must be under age 9 – not eligible for 4-H yet
  - 5) Quality of calf will not be a consideration
  - 6) Showman will answer and questions from judge
  - 7) All participants will receive a participation ribbon
  - 8) Ribbons & Plaques will provide a cash award to each entrant
  - 9) All entries will be released immediately after the show
  - 10) Entries will be taken up to the time of the show

**GENERAL RULES**

There will be a charge of \$1.00 per head. All applications for entries must be made upon printed forms which may be obtained free by writing the secretary. These forms are to be filled out and signed by the exhibitor. All cattle must be haltered and set to show as per display for premium, all others will be considered as a commercial exhibit. **REFER TO HEALTH REQUIREMENTS UNDER GENERAL RULES.** Exhibitors must keep their pens in the rear of their stalls clean and clear. All cattle must be shown where indicated by the superintendent of the department. Any violation of this rule will subject exhibitor to ejection from the grounds. All stock and larger trailers will be parked in their designated areas. Exhibitors must keep their stalls open and stock unbranded from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. during each day of exhibition. Exhibitors are expected to comply with the superintendent's property in producing their stock as directed. Stock must be in the ring within ten minutes after the class is called. Any person failing to comply with this rule is not an exhibitor for the premium offered. Exhibitors will show their animals at each time and place as they are directed, and shall furnish such information concerning their stock as may be required by the superintendent, and in case of refusal non-compliance with this rule any or all premiums will be forfeited and the exhibitor barred from showing.

Moving out in the daily classes I shall be the duty of the superintendent or his assistant to see that all cows have been milked out clean hot water that 2 p.m. of the day preceding the judging.
