All open class economics entries will be entered, judged, displayed, and measured in the Agricultural Hall. Exhibits may be entered **Wednesday, July 24 from 9:00 — 7:00 pm** or **Thursday, July 25 9:00 — 12:00pm.**

Please comply with all parking rules! No parking in entry areas, on sidewalks or on South side of Agricultural Hall.

Each exhibitor must obtain an exhibitor number before entering their items.

EXHIBITS MUST BE ENTERED BY JULY 26 AT 12:00 NOON. Judging begins at 1:00 pm. Agricultural Hall will be closed to the public during judging.

Exhibitors may enter an entry items in up many departments as they wish but ONLY one item per category.

All premium numbers are the same for all divisions.

Each exhibit will receive only one award and possibly a special award. Only five (5) awards per premium number/entry will be awarded. All special awards are in addition to the standard fair premiums and are the decision of the judge. Space will be assigned by the department chairman.

Youth Division: Dept. L.K. Exhibitors ages six to Fifteen (15) and Under are encouraged to participate in the "Youth" Division. All exhibitors in the youth division will also receive a participation ribbon for all other entries with no cash award.

Junior Division: in foods and sewing (Dept. H & K). Exhibitors that are 16 years-of-age but have not reached their 18th birthday by entry day of the current fair year are eligible.

All Participants/Awards will be \$1.00 for food items and \$1.00 for all others.
